The Council for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards met on the above date with Councillors Debbie Peplinskie, John Jeffrey, Ted Browne, Brian Pecoskie, Stanley Pecoskie and Carl Kuehl present. Mayor Janice Visneskie chaired the meeting, which she opened and called to order.

Pecuniary/Financial Interest: No pecuniary/financial interest was declared by any of the Council members present.

Purpose of Meeting: To review an application for a zoning amendment from Jesse Brook and Josee Ethier. The purpose and effect of the amendment is to rezone the severed lands in Consent File (B67/18) from Limited Service Residential (LSR) to Limited Service Residential – Exception Seven (LSR-E7) to implement a 30 metre water setback and to reduce the minimum lot frontage from 30 metres to 20 metres. All other provisions of Zoning B-Law will apply. Mayor Visneskie Moore read the following statement:

Mayor Visneskie asked if all necessary notices have been complied with and was told by the Acting CAO/Clerk-Treasurer that they had. The floor was opened to discussion and Mayor Visneskie informed those present of the following:

Section 34(11) of the Planning Act states that if Council decides to refuse an application or refuses or neglects to make a decision on an application within 120 days of the Municipal Clerk receiving the application, the applicant or the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, may appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal by filing an appeal with the Clerk of the Municipality.

Section 34(19) states that not later than 20 days after the giving of notice of passing of the by-law, the applicant, any person or public body who made oral submissions at the public meeting or made a written submission to Council before the by-law was passed, or the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, may appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal by filing an appeal with the Clerk of the Municipality.

Delegations: No delegations addressed Council in regard to the proposed zoning amendment, and no correspondence was received in this regard.
