PART A Tendering Procedures

1. All inquiries, concerning the tender, prior to tender closing, shall be directed to:

2. Notification of acceptance of tender will be by telephone and written form of notice, to the address of the Contractor used on the bid forms. The date of acceptance shall be deemed to be the date of receipt of the acceptance notice by the Contractor.
3. A tender may be voided by superseding it with a later tender or letter of withdrawal, prior to the closing date and time.

PART B Tendering Requirements

1. A certified cheque, made payable to the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards in the amount of 10% of the total tender must be submitted with the tender, for deposit purposes.

Deposit cheques of unsuccessful bidders will be returned within ten (10) business days of the tender opening. The cheque of the successful bidder shall be retained until the Municipality's acceptance of the completed work.

2. The successful bidder shall deliver a certified copy of the Firm's Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance Policy for the works, within ten (10) business days of

receiving the acceptance notice. Coverage shall be at least \$2,000,000 per accident and name the Municipality as an additional insured. Failure to provide such proof may result in cancellation of the contract and forfeiture of the bid deposit.

3. The successful bidder shall also deliver proof on request of Workers Compensation Insurance coverage, within ten (10) business days of receiving the acceptance notice.

PART C Basis of Rejection

Tenders not conforming to the following requirements will be disqualified:

- a) Tender must be legible, in ink, by typewriter or by printer. Entries or changes made in pencil shall, unless otherwise decided by the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards, be invalid. Tenders which are incomplete, illegible or obscure, or that contain additions not called for, erasures, alterations or irregularities of any kind, may be rejected.
- b) Tender must be on form provided.
- c) Tender must be in the possession of the Municipality by the closing date and time.
- d) Tender must be signed and sealed by an authorized official of the bidding organization. A joint tender must be signed and sealed by each company.
- e) All items must be bid.
- f) Tender must not be restricted or modified in any way.

Disqualifications

Under no circumstances will tenders be considered which:

- a) are received **after 4:30 pm, Local Time on Tuesday May 30th, 2017;**
- b) include tender qualifications or other conditions not authorized by the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards; or
- c) are in the determination of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards, incomplete.

Right to Accept or Reject

The tender which includes the lowest submitted cost will not necessarily be accepted. The Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards has the right to reject any and all tenders for any reason whatsoever. The Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards shall not be responsible for and potential bidders shall not be entitled to, reimbursement for any liability costs, expenses, loss, economic loss, damages or consequential damages incurred, sustained or suffered, including loss of profit, by any potential bidder prior or subsequent to, or by reason of the acceptance or the non-acceptance by the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards of any tender or by reason of any delay in the acceptance of a tender. Tenders are subject to formal acceptance by the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards and a formal contract being prepared and signed.

POTENTIAL BIDDERS ARE ADVISED THAT ACCEPTANCE OF ANY TENDER WILL BE DONE BY RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS COUNCIL.

Part D Acceptance

Award of Tender

The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. The Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards may, in its sole discretion;

- a) award a contract to the potential bidder that the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards, in its sole discretion, determines is the best qualified and compliant tender; or
- b) determines that the potential bidder meets the best possible competencies; or
- c) not award any contract at all.

The determination of the best qualified and compliant tender shall be at the sole discretion of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards, which decision shall be final and not challengeable.

PART E General Conditions

1. Performance Evaluation

Failure to execute the contract in a competent manner shall result in the bidder's disqualification from bidding on the Municipality's contracts for a period of two (2) years.

2. Engineer, Authority and Municipality

The terms; Corporation, Inspector, Engineer and Authority shall be deemed to be the Municipality.

3. Omissions, Discrepancies and Interpretations

Should a potential bidder find omissions from or discrepancies in any of the tender documents or be in doubt as to the meaning of any part of such documents, the potential bidder is required to contact the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards, no later than five (5) business days before the closing date. If the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards considers that a correction, explanation or interpretation is necessary or desirable, it will issue an addendum to all that have taken out tender documents.

4. Special Provisions

Special Provisions applicable to this tender are set out in Appendix "A" attached.

PART F COMPLETION DATE

The Contractor shall complete the work by **Friday, September 8th, 2017.**

If the time limit above is not sufficient to permit completion by the Contractor working a normal number of hours, the Contractor shall make changes to permit the work to be completed by the above date.

Additional costs incurred shall be deemed to be included in the price bid for the works. If the work is not complete by the above date, or by an amended date allowed by an approved extension of time, then the Contractor agrees to pay the Municipality a sum of \$100.00 per calendar day, for each day's delay in finishing the work, as liquidated damages.

APPENDIX "A"

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. The successful contractor will be responsible to pulverize and/or remove all asphalt at an estimated length of 1.4 Km and to remove asphalt at the intersection of Mill Street and Civic Street an estimated length of 14 m x 7 m width.
2. The successful contractor is responsible to replace two (2) culverts;
 - a) 12" x 60'
 - b) 36" x 60'Both culverts are to be compacted with granular "A".
3. The successful contractor is responsible for reshaping the estimated length of 1.4 Km of road plus the intersection at Mill Street and Civic Street with granular "A" $\frac{3}{4}$ grade and pack before asphalt.
4. The successful contractor is responsible for paving with hot mix 2" compacted full length and width of existing asphalt in addition to the intersection at Mill Street and Civic Street;
 - a) 11 m wide x 165 m in length from Queen Street to just past Civic Street on South side of road
 - b) Lane Street 50 m in length x 3 m wide taper to 2 m
 - c) Inside corner from Highway 60 from 50 m length, 11 m width taper to 8 m then to 6.5m
5. The successful contractor is responsible for paving two (2) separate water gutters at an estimated length of;
 - a) 96 m on creek side of road
 - b) 271 m on opposite side of Killaloe and District Housing Authority Inc. located at 31 Mill Street.
6. The successful contractor is responsible for shouldering the entire road with granular "A" after completion of paving.
7. The successful contractor is responsible for raising any man holes, catch basins, water valves etc. set to grade prior to paving at contractors expense.
8. The successful contractor is responsible for all grading, packing and any dust control if needed prior to paving.
9. The successful contractor is responsible for all utility locates as well as all required signage, traffic control, silt fence and any other permits as required.

The proceeds of this cheque shall, upon acceptance of the tender, constitute a deposit which shall be forfeited to the Municipality, if the Contractor fails to complete the work in accordance with the tender documents.

It is agreed that the tender quantities are estimated only and may be increased or decreased by the Municipality without alteration of the tender price. However, such increases or decreases shall not exceed 20%.

This offer shall be irrevocable for a period of thirty (30) calendar days following the date of tender opening.
