### **PUBLIC NOTICE – TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS**

The Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards is working to help our residents and ratepayers to recover from the 2017 flood, and to keep everyone safe and healthy.

The arrangement between the municipality and the Renfrew County District Health Unit for a temporary water sample drop off location at the township office has now been extended until **June 29, 2017 at 2:00 P.M**

The **Killaloe Waste Site - 1049 Mask Road**, will now be accepting flood debris (free of charge) during the regularly scheduled hours of operation until **June 30, 2017 at 4:00PM**. The hours for the site are as follows:

**Wednesday**

7:30AM – 11:30AM

**Friday**

12:00PM–4:00PMt

**Saturday**

8:00PM–4:00PM

To help protect our residents/ratepayers, and to ensure that sandbags are disposed of in an environmentally safe and responsible manner, the township will be issuing a tender for sandbag pick up. Please leave your sandbags in place on your property until the contractor picks them up. To assist us in providing the contractor with these locations, we also ask that you phone the township office at 613-757-2300, or email Lorna Hudder at [lhudder@khrtownship.ca](mailto:lhudder@khrtownship.ca) and provide your name, civic address and the number of sandbags that you have on your property for pick up.

Just a reminder that the township is waiving building permit fees associated to flood related repairs. Please contact the building department if you have further questions in this regard.
