It is with great sadness to report that in July of 2020 the Municipality became aware of potential unsafe conditions of the Hoch Farm Museum. The Municipality retained the services of a professional engineering company and based on the report the building has been deemed unsafe and not feasible to repair. Due to prolonged deterioration, the Hoch Farm Museum will have to be demolished.

We are in consultation with a production company “The Salvage Kings” in conjunction with Priestly Demolition to have the building demolished and the story featured on their show on the history channel at a later date.
