

# TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS

## BY-LAW NO. 32-2002

BEING a by-law to license "Transient Traders wishing to operate within the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards enacts as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited as the "Transient Trader By-Law".

2. Definitions:

Business	-A trade, calling, business, occupation, manufacture or industry and includes the sale, order or hire of goods and services on an intermittent or one-time basis.
Transient Trader	-Person who conducts a business on an adhoc basis and pays no business tax to the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards under the Assessment Act
Transient Trader's Place of business	- Any premise, real property, and public property including the streets of the Township.

3. Transient Trader:

Any person or persons wishing to carry on a business as a Transient Trader shall be required to obtain a license from the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards. The cost of said license shall be assessed on a fiscal year basis and shall be assessed as follows:

- Class # 1 - Door to door sales, magazines, encyclopedias, vacuum cleaners, etc. shall be assessed at the rate of \$ 100.00
- Class #2 - Mobile food units shall be assessed at the rate of \$20.00 per event no fee shall be assessed on units operated by non-profit organization groups.
- Class#3 – Transient photographers shall be assessed at the rate of \$100.00. School photographers are excepted.
- Class #4 - Midways shall be assessed at the rate of :
  - (a) Midway sponsored by a local organization \$100.00.
  - (b) Unsponsored midway shall pay \$500.00.
- Class #5- Produce stands, chip wagons--and-'8:dhoc food outlets shall be assessed at the rate of \$400.00.
- Class #6- Farmer markets shall be exempt from rate fee.

4. Licenses issued under this by-law are not transferable.

5. All licensees shall cause their license to be prominently displayed in their place of business or on their person if no premise is associated with their business, at all times that the said business is being conducted.

6. For the purpose of this by-law, a certificate of authorization from the Renfrew County Health Unit must be produced before a license will be issued. This requirement may be waived at the discretion of the Clerk.

7. Enforcement:

- (a) This by-law shall be enforced under the Provincial Offences Act by any person designated by the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards as an Enforcement Officer.
- (b) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable to a fine under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act.
- (c) For the purposes of this by-law, each day of continued offence shall be deemed to be a separate offence.

8. The Issuer of Licenses may refuse to issue a license unless and until compliance with the provisions of the By-law or any other requirements referred to herein, is established by the applicant, owner of the business or by the occupier of the premises for which the license is required.

9. This by-law shall come into force and effect on final reading thereof.

10. By-Law 11-2001 is hereby repealed.
