

Municipal Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards

By-Law # 38-2005

Being a By-Law to regulate parking on certain highways within the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards;

WHEREAS Section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001 permits a municipality to pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 170 (12) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, (hereinafter referred to as the HTA) parking or standing a vehicle on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic or the clearing of snow from the highway, is prohibited;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 170 (13) of the HTA, the provisions of Section 170 (12) of the HTA with respect to parking or standing in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic or with the clearing of snow from the highway do not apply to a portion of a highway in respect of which a municipal by-law prohibiting or regulating parking or standing in such a manner as to interfere with traffic or with the clearing of snow from the highway, as the case may be, is in force;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 170(15) of the HTA, a police officer, police cadet, municipal by-law enforcement officer or an officer appointed for the carrying out of the provisions of the Act, upon discovery of any vehicle parked or standing in contravention of subsection (12) or of a municipal by-law, may cause it to be moved or taken to and placed or stored in a suitable place and all costs and charges for moving, care and storage thereof, if any, are a lien upon the vehicle, which may be enforced in the manner provided by the *Repairs and Storage Liens Act, 1990, c. H.8, s.170(15)*.

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards enacts as follows:

1. Parking is permitted on the highway municipally known as Red Rock Road, in the following location;
 - (a) The East Side of the shoulder of Red Rock Road, for a distance of 150 meters on the North Side and the South Side of the main road entrance to Foy Provincial Park.

Penalty: Any person who contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offence, and on conviction is liable to a fine as set out in the HTA.

This by-law comes into force and takes effect upon the final date of passing.

Read a first and second time this 2nd day of August, 2005.

Read a third time and finally passed this 2nd day of August, 2005.
