

The Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards

By-Law #17 -2020

BEING A BY-LAW TO DELEGATE COUNCIL'S AUTHORITY

WHEREAS Section 23. (1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorized a municipality to delegate its powers and duties by by-law to a person or body subject to the restrictions set out in the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 23.3 (1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c25, as amended, provides restrictions and powers which cannot be delegated;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards deems it advisable to delegate certain authority and powers in the event that Council is unable to act due to the current COVID-19 pandemic;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Mayor and the CAO Clerk-Treasurer be delegated authority to make decisions, related to and/or during the COVID-19 pandemic, such as but not limited to the following:
 - (a) The hiring or dismissal of any employee of the municipality;
 - (b) The disposition of any real or personal property of the municipality which has a value exceeding \$50,000 at the time of disposal;
 - (c) Making any expenditures or incurring any other liability which exceeds \$15,000 (Procurement of Goods and Services) and;
 - (d) Human Resources Policies and Procedures as they pertain to staffing.
2. That the Mayor and CAO Clerk-Treasurer be given delegated authority to approve consultant appointments and contract awards that would normally require Council approval, that are Council approved budgetary expenditures.
3. That the Mayor and CAO Clerk-Treasurer will report to Council at the next meeting of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards Township council on any actions taken under the provisions of this by-law.
4. That the delegation of authority by-law will be limited to the time that Council is unable to hold its regular or special meetings of Council or committee meetings as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
5. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect following third reading. Once Council resumes its regular meeting schedule, the delegation of authority by-law will be rescinded.

Read a first and second time this 26th day of March 2020.

Read a third time and finally passed this 26th day of March 2020.
