

**THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF KILLALOE, HAGARTY AND RICHARDS**

BY-LAW NO. 31 - 2023

Being a by-law to establish sewage and water rates for the year 2023 to provide sufficient revenue to meet the estimates required for the operation of the Water and Sewage Plants.

WHEREAS Section 391(1)(a),(b),(c),(d) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a council of a local municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty & Richards has entered into an operating agreement with the Ontario Clean Water Agency for the supply of water and sewage service to the municipality and passed a five-year Financial Plan in 2020 for the Killaloe Water Treatment Plant.

AND WHEREAS the sewage rates are effective June 1, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards enacts as follows:

1. RATES:

<u>Sewage Rates:</u>	Residential	\$35.00 per month
	Commercial	\$38.00 per month
	Separate School	\$330.00 per month
	Public School	\$330.00 per month
<u>Water Rates:</u>	Residential	\$106.23 per month
	Small Commercial	\$119.51 per month
	Large Commercial	\$132.79 per month

As per the municipal financial plan approved by Council by resolution in July 2020, the water rates will increase by 6% each year until 2025 and increase by 2% in 2026.

2. PAYMENTS:

- a) All accounts shall be billed bi-monthly.
 - b) Penalty for nonpayment of 2(a) above shall be 1.25% per month and shall be applied to all unpaid sewage and/or water bills on the first day of each month following the due date.
 - c) Water and/or Sewer arrears persisting (6) six consecutive months beyond the billing date may result in the termination of water and/or sewer services to the delinquent premise and the amount and any related penalty and interest charges added to the tax roll for collection pursuant to the Tax Collection Policies and Procedures of the municipality.
 - d) Where service is disconnected at the request of the user a \$50.00 fee shall be received in advance before the service is reconnected.
 - e) Accounts may be paid in person at the Township Office at 1 John Street, Killaloe, Ontario by cash, cheque or debit, at CIBC in Killaloe, through telephone banking or by e-transfer.
3. A sewage and/or water service rate is hereby imposed upon the owners of lands which are supplied with sewage and/or water service as a consequence of the

entering into of the above-mentioned agreement with the Ontario Clean Water Agency.

4. For apartment buildings, all sewage and/or water service rates continue to be charged for each unit even if the unit is vacant unless the unit will cease to exist as a separate unit and will no longer be rented. The owner shall notify the office in writing once the unit ceases to exist.
5. If a commercial building or portion thereof becomes vacant and providing that the municipality is notified in writing by the owner, the commercial sewage and/or water service rate will be changed to the applicable residential rate.
6. All vacant lots or buildings on a property that are connected or where a connection is available will be charged the applicable sewage and/or water service rates.

THAT this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing thereof.

THAT this By-Law shall rescind all previous By-Laws pertaining to water and sewage rates.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED THIS 18th DAY OF JULY, 2023.
