**LOCATED ON COUNTY ROAD 512 (QUEEN STREET)  
 1.45 KILOMETERS SOUTH OF HIGHWAY 60**

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**WHY:** The bridge must undergo a major rehabilitation in order to extend its service life.

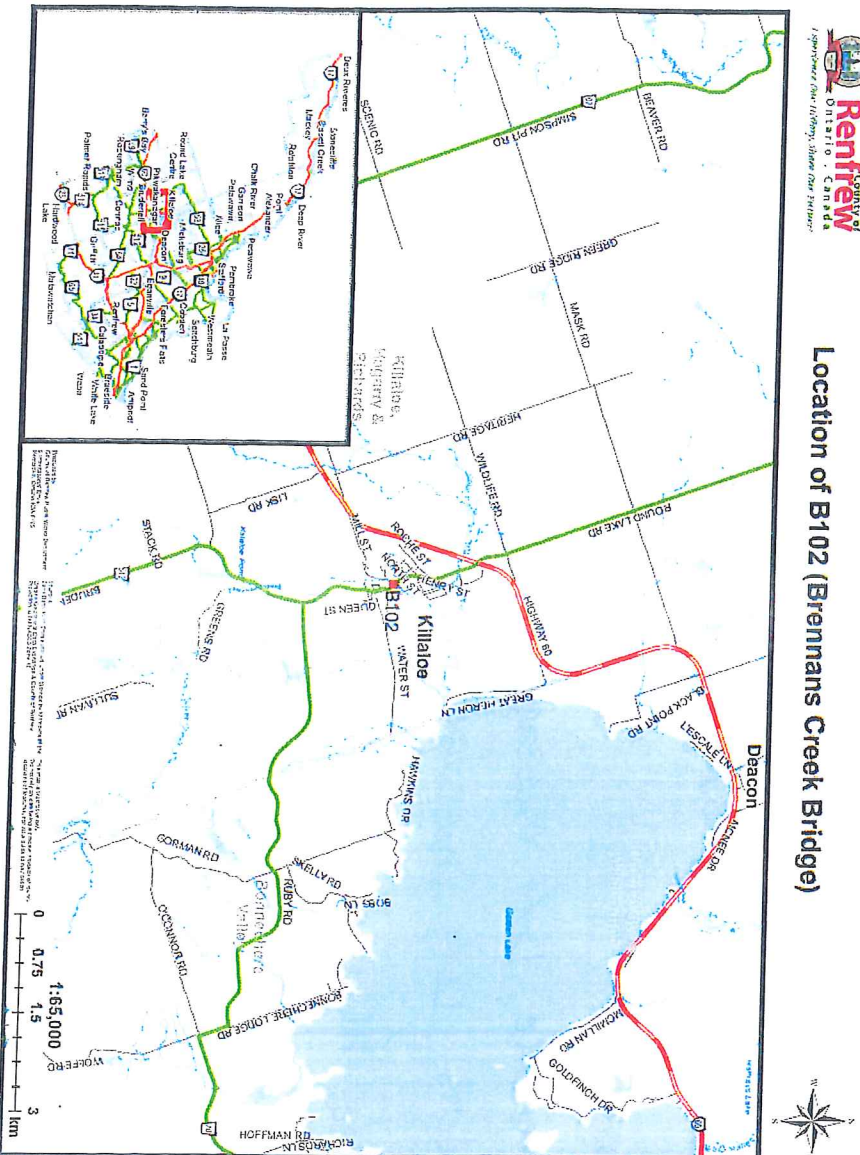
**WHAT:** Rehabilitation will require full closure of the bridge for the entire duration of the construction project.
