



## The Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards

Information Release

April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019

The Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards' emergency control group met at 1:00PM on Monday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to review and assess the flooding situation in the municipality. At 1:30PM Mayor Janice Visneskie Moore declared an emergency under the *Emergency Management and Protection Act*.

The declaration of an emergency is the result of rising water levels which pose a threat to municipal infrastructure along with property, health and safety of residents. Water levels have continued to rise and flood levels are forecasted to exceed levels experienced in 2017.

For safety, all property owners should monitor weather conditions, check for updated messages, and exercise caution near fast moving water. Residents should take appropriate precautions to protect their property. Sand and sandbags are available at designated locations across the municipality. Please see municipal website or Facebook page for these locations and for any other additional information you may require.

Please note regular township services may be affected as municipal resources are deployed to deal with flooding emergency.
