Echoes of Erin Returns! Comhaltas Tour Visits Killaloe and Pembroke

Once again the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards is hosting the Echoes of Erin.

The group will be performing at Festival Hall in Pembroke on Friday, September 30th at 7:00pm.

Monument To Be Unveiled

In October 2014, 75 women gathered in Renfrew County to envision the end to sexual violence; one thing they dreamed up was the creation of a permanent monument to honour survivors of sexual violence. The group pursued funding and were successful with the Ontario Arts Council and Ontario Women's Directorate. The result is a large permanent pebble mosaic in Eganville, and smaller art pieces throughout the County, including Killaloe.

The unveiling of the Killaloe monument will take place on Saturday, October 15th in Station Park in Killaloe at 10:00am. All are invited to attend.
