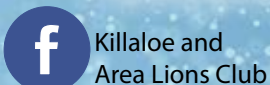

### Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Initiative in Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards

Round Lake Property Owners Association (RLPOA) president Rob Norris has been working on an initiative to make AED's more accessible to the public in the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards. The outcome of this initiative is to have available to everyone, an accessible AED three minutes within any direction of houses within the township. These units will be installed outside in heated cases. This initiative will be township wide and led by the County of Renfrew, RLPOA and KHR. There are three units installed so far; one at the Round Lake Fire Hall, one on Red Rock Road and one near Hummingbird Trail. As the units are made available, they will be registered with 911 so dispatchers can direct a caller to the closest AED. There is still a lot of work to be fulfilled and funds to be raised for this initiative to be fully operational. Still to be completed is the purchase of additional AED's, signage for both roadways and waterways and training-at-large for the community.

## Just a Reminder

**DO NOT PUSH SNOW OR ICE ONTO TOWNSHIP ROADS OR SIDEWALKS**

According to the Highway Traffic Act Section 181; No person shall deposit snow or ice on a roadway without permission in writing to do so from the Ministry of the road authority responsible for the maintenance of the road.

**Residents are asked to be mindful of parking on streets and roadways during the winter months.**

**Please take note:**

**Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards Township**

**Parking By-Law #02-2006**

No person shall park a vehicle on any street or roadway in any street or roadway in any of the following places, except in the case of an emergency:

Part 5.9 advises "parking in any such manner as to interfere with civic or municipal services such but not restricted to snowplowing, the removal of ice and snow or road maintenance". Part 7 advises "The Works Superintendent will be authorized to have an offending vehicle towed away during the winter months from November 1st to April 30th of each year as set out in this By-Law under part 3 – Parking Prohibited – General".

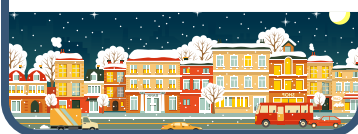

## **\*\*Bonnechere River Water Management Plan Update\*\***

Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) has approved the amendment using their approval process. The Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) and Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO) have not approved this amendment at this time.

Renfrew Power Generation (RGP), BOWFIN Environmental and the Algonquins of Ontario (AOO) Community members have collected vital data this past fall.

Communication with MECP and DFO are ongoing to develop a plan to move forward that works for everyone as soon as possible.

Without the approvals from DFO and MECP the new drawdown regime cannot be implemented, or penalties will be faced. MNRF will continue to monitor the conditions and act accordingly.
