Special Meeting

The Council for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards held a Special Meeting on the above date with Councillors Ernie Cybulski, Stanley Pecoskie, Carl Kuehl and Debbie Peplinskie present. Mayor Janice Visneskie chaired the meeting, which she opened and called to order.

Pecuniary/Financial Interest: No pecuniary/financial interest was declared by any council member present.

Purpose of Meeting: Mayor Visneskie advised that the purpose of the meeting is to discuss a trivia night for the recreation committees.

Delegations: Les Moore, Tim Summers of the Round Lake Recreation Committee and Ted Browne of the Friends of the Killaloe Rink were present. Mayor Visneskie explained that individual council members are willing to donate their time to assist in a Trivia Night, with the proceeds being split equally between the two aforementioned recreation groups. She advised that Councillor O'Reilly had arranged for the use of the Lions Hall on April 19th for this function. Council agreed to provide some seed funding for such incidentals as food, paper, pencils, etc. for this year, and if the event becomes an annual one, this would be the responsibility of the participating groups in future years. It was agreed that twenty teams consisting of six participants each, could be easily accommodated at the Lions Hall. Mr. Summers advised that he will inquire about having a trophy made for the event, and Council agreed that it should be called the Killaloe Centennial Cup in honor of the Killaloe Centennial year. Mr. Summers and Mr. Browne advised that they will work towards getting volunteers and teams together for the event. Council agreed to an entry fee of \$60.00 per team, and further agreed that teams could have a maximum of six players. Registrations will be accepted at the municipal office. Council also agreed to donate golf shirts, tee shirts and hats as door prizes. Individual council members were also encouraged to collect prize donations.
