

white privilege head on, acknowledging the wrongness of her upbringing and the aggressions and microaggressions committed within her community.

Proposed Comprehensive Zoning By-law

The purpose and effect of the new comprehensive Zoning By-law is to regulate the use of the land and the erection, location and use of buildings within the municipality. The new comprehensive Zoning By-law consists of text and maps which will implement the County of Renfrew Official Plan and the Provincial Policy Statement.

All of the existing Zoning By-laws in effect for the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards will be repealed and replaced with the provisions of the new Comprehensive Zoning By-law.

Since the proposed Zoning By-law affects lands throughout the entire Township, a key map or a description of the affected lands has not been provided.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Council of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards on the proposed Zoning By-law, you must make a written request to Tammy Gorgerat, CAO/Clerk-Treasurer, Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards.

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

NOTE: One of the purposes of the Planning Act is to provide for planning processes that are open, accessible, timely and efficient. Accordingly, all written submissions, documents, correspondence, e-mails or other communications (including your name and address) form part of the public record and will be disclosed/made available by the Municipality to such persons as the Municipality sees fit, including anyone requesting such information. Accordingly, in providing such information, you shall be deemed to have consented to its use and disclosure as part of the planning process.



Every year in KHR we host our annual Municipal Hazardous & Special Waste Day in August and every year we receive hundreds of items that residents hold on to all year that could have been taken to our landfill site.
