Annual Library Holiday Open House and the KHR Tree Lighting

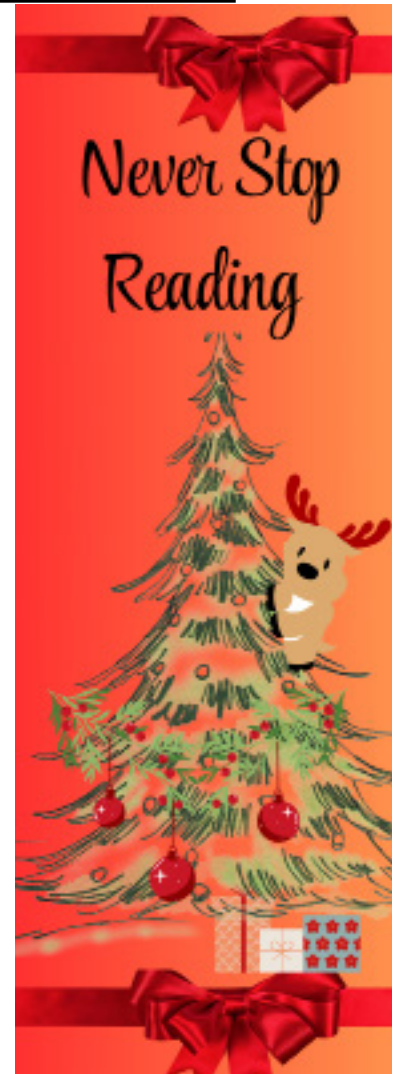

Winter Shovelling

Tips



Winter snow shoveling can be tough, but with the right approach, it's manageable and safer.

5 Quick Tips:

- Warm up: Stretch before shoveling to prevent injury.
- Use a lightweight shovel: Reduce strain on your back.
- Shovel often: Keep snow manageable by clearing it frequently.
- Lift with your legs: Avoid back strain by bending your knees.
- Dress in layers: Stay warm without overheating.
