FYI Alert: Watch Out for Zebra Mussels!

Attention all watercraft riders:

Zebra mussels are invasive species threatening our waterways. These small mollusks can clog pipes, disrupt ecosystems, and harm native species.



What to do:



Inspect Your Bost. Thoroughly exemine all surfaces of your bost, including the hull, prepallers, rudders, and any equipment that has been submerged in water.

Look for Signs: Check for clusters of zebra mussels attached to surfaces. They are typically small (less than an inch). Proposition and have alternating light and dark

<u>Semove Them Safely.</u> If you find zebra mussels or their shells, scrape them off with a putty knife, brush, or other tools. Dispose of them in the trash or on dry land away from water bodies. Do not flush them down drains or toilets.

Clean and Dry Gear, Rinse and dry all gear, including anchors, ropes, and trailers, to remove any potential zebra mussel larvae (veligers).

Spread the Word: Help prevent their spread by educating others about the importance of inspecting and cleaning watercraft.

Bridge Construction

TRAMORE BRIDGE - COUN-TY STRUCTURE B108

Located on Tramore Road, approximately 0.25km north of County Road 58 (Round Lake Rd.), the rehabilitation of Tramore Bridge is scheduled to commence in mid-July with an anticipated completion by early October.

During this period, the bridge will be closed to all traffic to facilitate construction activities. A designated detour route has been established, directing motorists via County Road 58 and Highway 60.

BRENNAN'S CREEK - COUNTY STRUCTURE B102

Situated on County Road 512 (Queen Street), about 1.45km south of Highway 60 in Killaloe, the rehabilitation of Brennans Creek Bridge began in early July and is projected to conclude by late August.

To ensure public safety, the bridge will be closed to traffic throughout the rehabilitation period. Pedestrian access, however, will be maintained to accommodate foot traffic.

Clear and prominent signage has been installed in the vicinity, providing motorists with alternate routes via Cameron Street and Lake Street.




