The Council of the Township of Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards met on the above date with, Mayor Dave Mayville, Councillors Harold Lavigne, Bil Smith, Maureen MacMillan, Ted Browne, Carl Kuehl and Brian Pecoskie present.

Mayor Dave Mayville chaired the meeting, which he opened and called to order.

First Nations Land Acknowledgement:

First Nations Land Acknowledgement read by Mayor Mayville:

As we gather today, I would like to acknowledge on behalf of Council and our community that we are meeting on the traditional territory of the Algonquin People. We would like to thank the Algonquin people and express our respect and support for their rich history, and we are extremely grateful for their many and continued displays of friendship. We also thank all the generations of people who have taken care of this land for thousands of years.

<u>Moment of Silent Reflection:</u> Mayor Mayville requested a moment of silent reflection.

<u>Pecuniary/Financial Interest:</u> No pecuniary/financial interest was declared by any of the Council members present.

Purpose of the Meeting: To review an application for a zoning amendment from Geoffrey Meakin and Richard Foy. The purpose of the amendment is to rezone the severed lands in Consent Application B159/23 from Rural (RU) to Limited Service Residential (LSR) so that the entire enlarged lot are in the same zone. All other provisions of the respective Zoning By-Law will apply.

Mayor Mayville advised of the following:

Section 34(11) of the Planning Act states that if Council decides to refuse an application or refuses or neglects to make a decision on an application within 120 days of the Municipal Clerk receiving the application, the applicant or the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, may appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal by filing an appeal with the Clerk of the Municipality.

Section 34(19) states that not later than 20 days after the giving of notice of passing of the by-law, the applicant, any person or public body who made oral submissions at the public meeting or made a written submission to Council before the by-law was passed, or the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, may appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal by filing an appeal with the Clerk of the Municipality.

CAO/Clerk – Treasurer Gorgerat advised that all necessary notices had been complied with.

<u>Correspondence:</u> No correspondence was received.

<u>Delegations:</u> No delegations were present.
